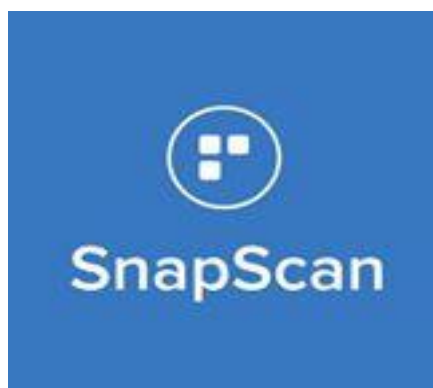

## **Are you Government funded?**

No, we solely rely on donations from companies and individuals

## **Who do you help?**

We service the Helderberg Community, this includes animals, and children to the elderly

## **What donations do you need?**

We welcome any donation in a good condition (items that's reusable) in and around your house and garage.

## **Do you fix appliances?**

No, we do not fix any appliances, but we do exchange it at the metal scrap yard for funds for Halli Trust

## **Does the Needlework Club do alterations on donated items?**

Unfortunately, not, they make new garments for themselves. They are only at the office on Friday mornings.

## **Do you collect donations?**

We prefer donations to be dropped off. If there is no other way, we can collect.

## **What are your operating hours?**

Monday to Fridays – 8h00 till 16h00 (Drop offs for donations can still be made afterhours till 18h00)

## **How do you decide which families/individuals receive help?**

We have 3 Community Representatives that lives in our communities, who then assesses the family/individual before we help. They then make sure the donation goes to the correct household.

## **Do you take Volunteers?**

Yes, we do! Email [heidi@hallitrust.co.za](mailto:heidi@hallitrust.co.za) with your ID document/birth certificate and ask for the application forms. We'd love the volunteers to do donation drives for us.
