


We have started with a new life skill/leadership program and selected children to walk a 3-year journey with us.





Are you Government funded?

No, we solely rely on donations from companies and individuals

Who do you help?

We service the Helderberg Community, this includes animals, and children to the elderly

What donations do you need?

We welcome any donation in a good condition (items that's reusable) in and around your house and garage.

Do you fix appliances?

No, we do not fix any appliances, but we do exchange it at the metal scrap yard for funds for Halli Trust

Does the Needlework Club do alterations on donated items?

Unfortunately, not, they make new garments for themselves. They are only at the office on Friday mornings.

Do you collect donations?

We prefer donations to be dropped off. If there is no other way, we can collect.

What are your operating hours?

Monday to Fridays – 8h00 till 16h00 (Drop offs for donations can still be made afterhours till 18h00)


How do you decide which families/individuals receive help?
